Cells have been fixed and treated for observation by epifluorescence microscopy; cellular actin is labeled with the phalloidin Alexa Fluor 647 (blue), and DNA is labeled with 4',6-diamidino-2-phenylindole (DAPI) (for which a red color has been assigned using Adobe Photoshop).
